5:9 I wrote to you in my letter not to associate with sexually immoral persons ... or greedy, or is an idolater, reviler, drunkard, or robber. Do not even eat with such a one

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- 16 **For** I am not ashamed of the gospel; it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who has faith, to the Jew first and also to the Greek. 17 For in it the righteousness of God is revealed through faith for faith; as it is written, "The one who is righteous will live by faith." 18 For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and wickedness of those who by their wickedness suppress the truth.
- 19 **For** what can be known about God is plain to them, because God has shown it to them. 20 For ever since the creation of the world his eternal power and divine nature, invisible though they are, have been understood and seen through the things he has made.

- B. 26 For this reason God gave them up to dishonourable emotions. Their females exchanged the natural [use?] for the against nature, 27 and in the same way also the males, giving up natural [use?] of females, were inflamed in their longing to one another. Males in males did shame and received in themselves the due penalty for their error.
- C. 28 **And since** they did not see fit to acknowledge God, God gave them up to an unreliable **mind** and to things that should not be done. 29 They were filled with every kind of wickedness, evil, covetousness, malice. - 2. Honourable sex with the correct partners ('Greco-Roman').
 - Paul is discussing sex with the wrong partners.
- 3. Any heterosexual sex

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WHIDESPALL MENTION SAME-SEXP

- 1. To reinforce the heterosexual ideal.
- 2. As an easy example of commonly agreed upon bad behaviour.
- 3. Because Paul has a negative view on sex and sexual attraction.

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WHY PAUL'S REASONS DON'T WORK FOR US

- 1. We have not adopted most of Paul's sexual theology.
- 2. Paul sees same-sex as turning away from natural intercourse, this is untrue.
- 3. Paul does not understand that LGBT+ is an identity and not (solely) an activity.
- 4. Paul's mentions of same sex are part of rhetorical strategy, meant to discredit other groups not theological discussion.

PAULIS PRO-LGBT+

27 As many of you as were baptized into Christ have clothed yourselves with Christ. 28 There is no longer Jew or Greek, there is no longer slave or free, there is no longer male and female; for all of you are one in Christ Jesus. 29 And if you belong to Christ, then you are Abraham's offspring, heirs according to the promise.

Galatians 3:27-29.

POINTS TO REMEMBER

- 1. Homosexuality is not mentioned, only homoerotic activity.
- 2. In Romans God makes men desire men.
- 3. Lesbians are not mentioned.
- 4. If Paul is against same-sex, he is also against certain types of hetero-sex.
- 5. Paul mentions these things as generic examples.
- 6. Paul's examples depend on his understanding of 'natural', biology, science and worldview have changed since then.
- 7. Paul says gender does not exist in Christ.
